

Director of Music Ministry

Position Description:

The Director of Music Ministry is responsible for the music ministry of Oak Lawn United Methodist Church with the goal of providing leadership in discipleship and worship through music. The position works independently on many tasks, but will also work as a team with other members of the staff and congregation.

Primary Duties & Responsibilities:

- Direct & lead the Chancel Choir's weekly rehearsals and Sunday morning.
- Direct & lead the handbell choir's rehearsals/performances as scheduled.
- Oversee and maintain the choirs' performance calendars, as well as any special music needs.
- Contact and obtain any necessary contract musicians for special occasions.
- Communicate effectively with volunteers, staff and congregation of OLUMC regarding activities, events, fundraisers and needs through various means of communications.
- Provide effective and empathetic pastoral care to congregation members.
- Assist with worship planning, worship leadership and discipleship opportunities as a part of the ministry team.
- Fulfill additional responsibilities as requested by Senior Pastor.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree in Music, including Choral Conducting. Masters of Sacred Music, a plus.
- Belief in the tenets and theology of The United Methodist Church, as well as support for and adherence to the beliefs and practices of Oak Lawn United Methodist Church.
- Familiarity with current events and social issues as related to faith.
- Strong technological skills utilizing most current platforms and options.
- Ability to comply with schedule which will include weekday office hours and significant time on Sundays.
